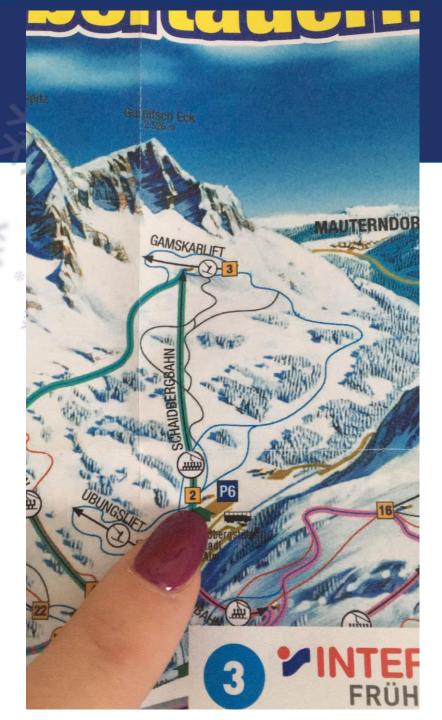














Ski School

Kit list

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Essential ski clothing items:

- 1 x ski Jacket- no other coat is needed.
- 1 x salopettes (ski trousers)
- Goggles (A must-have to protect eyes against the elements. They should be UVA/UVB protected.)
- Ski socks. I recommend at least 3 pairs for hygiene reasons.
- 1 pair of ski gloves Made from thermal and water resistant material.
- Silk or merino wool glove inners not compulsory but useful if your suffer particularly with cold hands
- Thermal Underwear (Top and Bottom) X3
- Thin fleece tops (long-sleeved) make a good additional layer.
- Neck warmer/buff
- High performance face & lip sun cream The sun's rays are more powerful when reflected off the snow.

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Other clothes items:

- Hat
- Normal changes of underwear and socks for 7 days.
- Nightwear.
- Swimwear and towel.
- Clothes for seven evenings including warm tops for evening activities which will involve us leaving the hotel.
- Toiletries
- Towel.
- Sensible footwear (for evening activities) e.g. trainers/flat boots
