

# The Governing Body

## **Full Board**

#### **Main Purpose**

The Full Board of the Governing Body

- needs to take a strategic role, act as a critical friend to the school and be accountable for its decisions;
- should set aims and objectives and agree, monitor and review policies, targets and priorities.

#### Terms of reference

- To agree constitutional matters\*, including procedures where the Governing Body has discretion.
- To set, monitor and evaluate the vision and the overall strategic direction of the school\*.
- To review the delegation arrangements annually\*.
- To recruit new members as vacancies arise and to appoint new governors\* where appropriate.
- To hold at least three Governing Body meetings a year\*, not counting the initial Business Meeting.
- To appoint or remove the Chair and Vice Chair\*.
- To appoint or remove a Clerk to the Governing Body\*.
- To establish the committees of the Governing Body and their terms of reference\*.
- To appoint the Chair of any committee (if not delegated to the committee itself).
- To appoint or remove a Clerk to each committee\*.
- To decide which functions of the Governing Body will be delegated to committees, groups and individuals\*.
- To allocate Governors to specific roles to oversee operational; aspects of the school.
- To receive reports from any individual or committee to whom a decision has been delegated and to consider whether any further action by the Governing Body is necessary\*
- To receive and ratify the previous year's budget, year-end accounts and break down for future budgets
- To approve the first formal budget plan of the financial year
- To keep the Health and Safety Policy and its practice under review and to make revisions where appropriate
- To establish a Pay Policy for all categories of staff and to be responsible for its administration and review.
- To receive termly reports on aspects of the school's operation, including areas of Safeguarding, SEND and Children who are Looked After.
- To take any other decision not delegated to school staff or a committee.

\*these matters cannot be delegated to either a committee or an individual

#### Quorum

One half of the number of Governors currently appointed.
