Dear Parents and Carers,

The National Education Union has called on its members to take strike action on Wednesday 1st February. The union's dispute is with the Secretary of State, not our school. This is because "she has failed to give the undertaking sought by the NEU to make available additional and sufficient funds to allow employers to pay a fully funded increase in teachers' pay at a rate greater than inflation".



There is not sufficient certainty that there will be adequate staffing levels to safely teach or supervise pupils on the proposed day of industrial action by members of the National Education Union. Consequently, Walkwood will be closed to all pupils on that day. There will be no clubs after school on that day. Please be mindful that the situation in each school will be different.



Home learning will be made available to pupils on ePraise and will be uploaded by late afternoon on Tuesday 31st January. Arrangements will be made for those pupils who are eligible for free school meals (these will be directly shared with the parents and carers of the pupils).

These measures will apply for **Wednesday 1st February**. There cannot be an assumption that the same closure provision will apply on future intended strike days of Wednesday 1st March, Wednesday 15th and Thursday 16th March 2023. It is our intention to provide at least a week's notice of our school's ability to accommodate pupils on these dates.








Prime bottles
