

Christmas Lunch 2024

Christmas lunches this year will be held on Tuesday 10th and Wednesday 11th December 2024. If your child wishes to have a Christmas lunch, the cost will be £4.00, to be paid via Parentpay.

Years 5 and 7 will have their Christmas lunches on Tuesday 10th December, while Years 6 and 8 Christmas lunches the following day.

There will be no other catering available on these days, so pupils who do not wish to have a Christmas lunch will need to bring in a packed meal from home. Those who take free school lunches will be provided with their meal. (A Christmas meal on their allocated day and a packed lunch on the other day).

Please note that when paying by Parentpay, the Christmas lunch option will be listed as a separate item so that we can identify the number of meals required. Please select the Christmas lunch item (log in to Parentpay, then go into 'pay for other items') and ensure that you make your payment by 8th December 2024.
