Parents, please be aware of the below parking restrictions outside school. We have noticed an increase in parents parking on the yellow zig zags/keep clear signs. They are in place to protect our children as they arrive and leave school site. Thank you.

Yellow zigzag lines: Do not park on or opposite yellow zigzag lines, which indicate areas where stopping is not permitted.

Keep clear markings: Do not park on school keep clear markings, which are often blue.

Dropped kerbs and drives: Do not park across dropped kerbs or drives.

Footpaths: Do not park on footpaths.

Yellow lines: Do not park on yellow lines, which can obstruct pedestrian sight lines.


Pedestrian crossings: Do not park on pedestrian crossings.




