Last week, a group of PhD students from the University of Birmingham held a workshop for some Year 7 and 8 pupils, exploring the wonders of topology. Our visitors explained that, in simple terms, topology is the study of shapes and spaces and how they can be stretched or deformed without tearing. The children were challenged to build a bridge using only a single cardboard box, with the rule that they could only remove material, not add any. This activity encouraged creativity and teamwork, leading to some excellent designs. The visitors were very impressed with the students' curiosity and exemplary behaviour throughout the workshop.



Road Safety


