Dear Parents and Carers,

Monday had the England game coinciding with school time. Mr West made a strong case for pupils having the opportunity to watch the national team, and so it was! We were initially uncertain if our usually strong broadband would hold up to the challenge of 24 classrooms also streaming the match, so two of the Colleges were stationed in the hall.

I lost count of the number of goals due to the cacophony that was coming from all those who were together in the hall. The variety of sounds was rather interesting, but the common engagement with the event was very clear.

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

#### **Attendance Points Boosters**

- These points are awarded at the end of every Week 2

#### **Zero Demerit Points Boosters**

A reward for all pupils who continue to demonstrate excellent focus and behaviour in and out of lessons.

- We are awarding a 5-point booster for every time your child has Zero Demerits during the period of the 2-week timetable- Week 1 & Week 2.
- Again, these points are awarded at the end of every Week 2


This is not compulsory! There will be pupils and adults who will be in their usual attire. School will finish at the usual time: ho, ho, ho!


